3	Pergamos	... he which hath the sharp <b>sword</b> with <b>two edges.</b> (2:12)	... <b>I know thy works</b> ... thou holdest fast my name, and hast not denied my faith ... Antipas was my faithful martyr. (2:13)	... where thou <b>dwest</b> , even where <b>Satan's seat</b> is. (2:13) ... thou has them that hold the doctrine of <b>Balaam</b> , who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto <b>idols</b> , and to commit <b>fornication</b> . So has thou also them that hold the doctrine of the <b>Nicolaitans.</b> (2:14, 15)	<b>He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches ...</b> (2:17) ... to him that overcometh will I give to eat of the <b>hidden manna</b> , and will give him a <b>white stone</b> , and in the stone a <b>new name</b> written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it. (2:17)
4	Thyatira	... the <b>Son of God</b> , who hath his <b>eyes</b> like unto a flame of <b>fire</b> , and his <b>feet</b> are like <b>fine brass.</b> (2:18)	... <b>I know thy works</b> , and charity, and service, and faith, and thy patience, and thy works; and the last to be more than the first. (2:19) ... <b>hold fast till come</b> ... (2:25)	... thou sufferest that <b>woman Jezebel</b> , which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants to commit <b>fornication</b> and to eat things sacrificed unto <b>idols.</b> (2:20)	... he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give <b>power over the nations</b> ; and he shall rule them with the <b>rod of iron</b> ; as the vessels of the potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father. And I will give him the <b>morning star.</b> (2:26, 27, 28) <b>He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches ...</b> (2:29)
5	Sardis	... he that hath the <b>seven Spirits</b> of God, and the <b>seven stars.</b> (3:1)	... <b>I know thy works.</b> (3:1) (but they had a name that thou livest, and art dead) ... <b>come on thee as a thief</b> ... (3:3)	... thou hast a <b>name</b> that thou <b>livest</b> , and art <b>dead.</b> (3:1) ... things that are ready to die: for I have not found thy <b>works</b> perfect before God. (3:2)	... he that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in <b>white raiment</b> ; and I will not blot out his name out of the <b>book of life</b> , but I will <b>confess his name</b> before my Father and before his angels. (3:5) <b>He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches ...</b> (3:6)
6	Philadelphia	... he that is <b>holy</b> , he that is <b>true</b> , he that hath the <b>key of David</b> , he that openeth, and no man shutteth; and no man openeth. (3:7)	... <b>I know thy works.</b> ... thou hast little strength, and hast kept <b>my word</b> , and not denied <b>my name.</b> (3:8) (Kelly) ... thou hast kept <b>the word</b> of my patience. (3:10) ... <b>I come quickly</b> ... (3:11)	... little strength. (3:8) (Kelly)	... keep thee from the <b>hour of temptation</b> ... him that overcometh will I make a <b>pillar</b> in the <b>temple of my God</b> , and he will go no more out: and I will write upon him the <b>name of my God</b> and the <b>name of the city of my God</b> , which is <b>new Jerusalem</b> , which cometh down from heaven from my God: and I will write upon him <b>my new name.</b> (3: 12) <b>He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches ...</b> (3:13)
7	Laodicea	... the <b>Amen</b> , the <b>faithful</b> and <b>true witness</b> , the beginning of the <b>creation of God.</b> (3:14)	... <b>I know thy works.</b> (3:15) (but they were neither cold nor hot) ... <b>I will spue thee out of my mouth</b> ... (3:16) (after His coming)	... I will <b>spue thee out</b> of my mouth. Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked. (3:16, 17)	... to him that overcometh will I grant to sit upon <b>my throne</b> , even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his <b>throne.</b> (3:21) <b>He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches ...</b> (3:22)
