A person who professes to be a Christian yet willingly and knowingly teaches false doctrine as though it were the truth of God, might be described in this way: 'That man is a *heretic*! He teaches *heterodox* doctrine concerning the Person of Christ. That *heresy* is horribly blasphemous.'
